

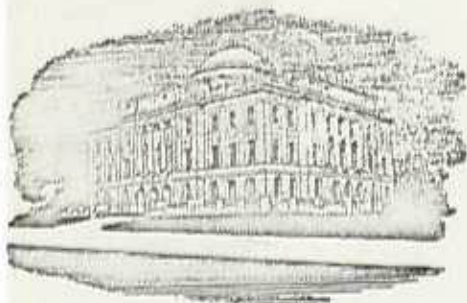



NOTICE OF ANNEXATION HEARING

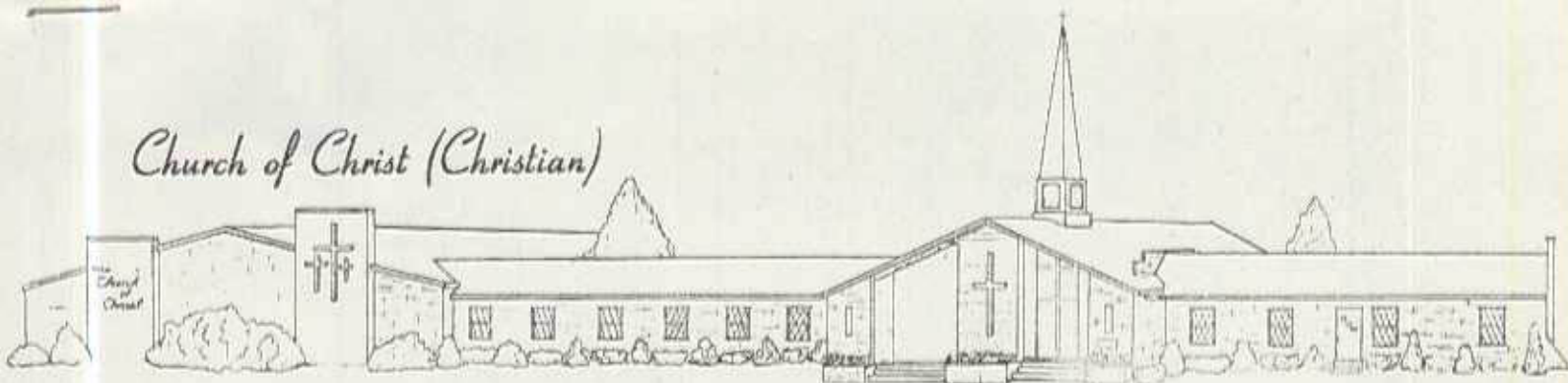

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Proposed Annexation to the City of Wilmington
(2.92 Acres)

Situated in Union Township, Clinton County, Ohio, and being a part of Military Survey No. 1057 and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the Southerly margin of Preston Drive at the Northeasterly corner of Lot No. 20 in McDermott Village Subdivision,
Section 1:

Running thence, from said point of beginning, with the lines of the lands of the Church of Christ, on the following courses: (1) S 88° 20' E 338.07 feet to a point; (2) S 1° 00' W 372.83 feet to a point; thence N 89° 31' W 337.77 feet to a point; thence, with the lines of the lands of the Church of Christ, on the following courses: (1) N 1° 00' E 128.96 feet to a point; (2) N 0° 56' E 250.83 feet to the point of beginning, containing Two and Ninety-two Hundredths (2.92) Acres, more or less.
