WHEREAS, the Annexation Agreement (attached hereto and incorporated by reference as "Exhibit E") to be attached to the Owner's Petition for Annexation furthers the general health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Wilmington and is necessary under Ohio Revised Code 709.022 and 709.192 for the Owner to file an expedited annexation petition thereunder;

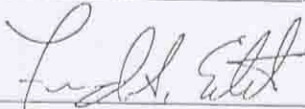
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 2. Annexation of the Real Estate is hereby authorized, contingent upon the approval of the Owner's Petition for Annexation of the Real Estate by the Clinton County Commissioners;

SECTION 3. The Director of Law is hereby appointed to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect annexation of the Real Estate.

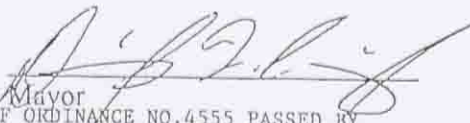

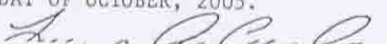

PETITION BY OWNER OF REAL ESTATE
FOR ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF WILMINGTON
Ohio Revised Code 709.022

To the Board of County Commissioners of Clinton County, State of Ohio:

- (1) The undersigned, being the agent for the owner of a certain territory consisting of 2.350 acres, more or less, located in MS No. 2690, Union Township, Clinton County, Ohio, hereby petitions for the annexation of the said 2.350 acres of territory to the City of Wilmington, Clinton County, Ohio.
- (2) The territory proposed for annexation is adjacent to and contiguous with the City of Wilmington. The Board of Commissioners is requested to follow the expedited Type 1 annexation procedures pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 709.022.
- (3) An accurate legal description of the boundaries of the territory proposed for annexation is attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A."
- (4) An accurate map or plat of the territory proposed for annexation is attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit "B."
- (5) Karen Buckley has been appointed agent for the petitioner and as such, has full power to: amend, increase or decrease the area; to do any and all things essential thereto; and to take any action necessary for obtaining the granting of this petition, without further expressed consent of the petitioners.
- (6) A list of all owners, tracts, lots, and parcels in the territory proposed for annexation, which has been simultaneously filed with the clerk of the board, is attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit "C."
- (7) A list of all persons owning property adjoining the territory proposed for annexation, which has been simultaneously filed with the clerk of the board, is attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit "D."
- (8) A certified copy of the Annexation Agreement entered into by Union Township, the City of Wilmington, and A. Dale Adkins, E. Lynne Adkins and David L. Adkins is attached as Exhibit "E."

- (9) WHOEVER SIGNS THIS PETITION EXPRESSLY WAIVES THEIR RIGHT TO APPEAL ANY ACTION ON THE PETITION TAKEN BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. THERE ALSO IS NO APPEAL FROM THE BOARD'S DECISION IN THIS MATTER IN LAW OR IN EQUITY.

Situated in Union Township, Clinton County, Ohio, VMS No. 2690, and being part of a 536.23 acre tract as conveyed by deed to Janet M. Williams Trustee as recorded in Volume 349, Page 119 of the Clinton County Official Records and being more particularly described as follows: Commencing for reference in the southerly margin of Rombach Avenue at an iron pin set marking the northwesterly corner of John C. & Nancy A. Williams' 1.000 acre tract (OR 125, Page 501) as surveyed and recorded in Volume 24, Plat No. 36 of the Clinton County Engineers Record of Land Division; thence with the line of said 1.000 acre tract S. 16° 25' 07" E. 190.42' to a ½" iron pin found at the southeasterly corner of A. Dale Adkins, E. Lynne Adkins Trustees and David L. Adkins' remaining part of a 1.38 acre tract (OR 492, Page 602), also being a corner to the Corporation of the City of Wilmington and being the True Point of Beginning for this tract herein described; thence continuing with the Corporation line of the City of Wilmington, the line of said Williams 1.000 acre tract and being the line of Wilmington Auto Group Realty LLC's 1.009 acre tract and 2.987 acre tract (OR 421, Page 915) S. 16° 25' 07" E. 409.59' to a ½" iron pin found; thence by new division line through the lands of Williams Trustee S. 74° 09' 15" W. 249.99' to an iron pin set in the line of the National Bank & Trust Company's 292.015 acre tract (OR 180, Page 818); thence with the line of said 292.015 acre tract N. 16° 24' 50" W. 409.59' to a 5/8" iron pin found at the corner of said Adkins et al's remaining part of a 1.38 acre tract; thence with the line of said 1.38 acre tract N. 74° 09' 12" E. 249.95' to the True Point of Beginning **containing 2.350 acres of land, more or less**, subject to all legal highways, easements, conditions and restrictions of record.

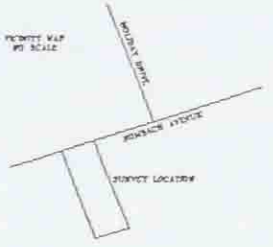

ANNEXATION AGREEMENT

This ANNEXATION AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is entered into by and between the City of Wilmington (the "City"), the Board of Trustees of Union Township, Clinton County, Ohio (the "Township"), and property owner, A. Dale Adkins, E. Lynne Adkins and David L. Adkins, (the "Adkins") in order to document their agreement with respect to a proposed annexation of property to the City.

RECITALS

- A. Whereas, the Adkins, the owners of certain real property more fully described on the attached "Exhibit A" (the "Property") and shown on the drawing attached as "Exhibit B," have expressed an intent to petition to have the Property annexed to the City pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.022; and
- B. Whereas, annexation into the City and responsible economic development of the Property will benefit the citizens of the Township and the citizens of the City; and
- C. Whereas, this Agreement is authorized by and the parties intend that it be in conformity with Ohio Revised Code Section 709.192; and
- D. Whereas, entry into this Agreement by the City has been authorized by City of Wilmington Resolution No. 4555, passed on the 6th day of October, 2005, effective thirty (30) days thereafter; and
- E. Whereas, entry into this Agreement by the Township has been authorized by Union Township Resolution No. 9 21 2005 2, passed on the 21st day of September, 2005;

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, obligations and undertakings contained herein, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. City Services to Annexed Property. From and after the effective date of annexation, the Property shall be excluded from the Township and the City shall provide such public services to the Property as are provided to other property located within the City. Under no circumstances shall the City be required to make improvements to the Property so as to provide services (e.g. sewer lines or equipment, water lines, etc.).
- 2. Payments by the City to the Township in Lieu of Taxes; Inside Millage. On January 31, 2006, and each such date thereafter for a period of ten (10) years (up to and including for the tax year ending December 31, 2015), the City shall make a payment to the Township in lieu of the real property taxes within the ten (10) mill limitation which the Township would have received in the prior year had the Property not been annexed into the City. Such payment shall be equal to the assessed valuation of the Property in the prior tax year, multiplied by 1.2, which factor equals the inside millage tax rate in effect for the Property as of January, 2004. Changes in the valuation of the property over the term of the Agreement shall be reflected in corresponding changes in the payments to the Township.

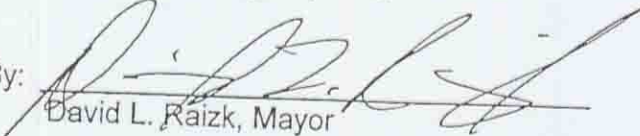
3. Miscellaneous Provisions. The following are also an integral part of this Agreement:
- A. Further Assurances. Each party agrees to cooperate fully with the other and to execute any additional instruments documents or agreements reasonably requested by the other party in order to carry out and fulfill all of the intents and purposes of this Agreement.
 - B. Entire Agreement/Amendments. This Agreement shall be construed to include all of the Exhibits referenced in and attached to this Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes all prior discussions, negotiations, proposals, and agreements between the parties (whether written or oral) and it may not be amended or modified except by a written amendment executed by all of the parties.
 - C. Agreement Severable. If any provision of this Agreement is ultimately determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, said provision shall be null and void, but the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall remain in effect.
 - D. Time of the Essence. The parties acknowledge that time is of the essence and therefore the parties agree to exert their respective best efforts to cause all of the actions contemplated by this Agreement to be effectuated as soon as possible.
 - E. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
 - F. No Third Party Beneficiaries. Nothing in this Agreement, expressed or implied, is intended to confer any rights or remedies upon any person, other than the parties hereto, and, subject to any restrictions on assignments herein.
 - G. No Waiver. The waiver or failure to enforce any provisions of this Agreement shall not operate as a waiver of any future breach of any such provision or any other provision hereof. Any forbearance or delay by a party in exercising any right, power or remedy under this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver thereof, and any single or partial exercise of any right, power or remedy shall not preclude the further exercise thereof of any other available remedy.
 - H. Effect of Agreement. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and bind the heirs, executors, administrators, assignees, and successors of the respective parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties by and/or through their duly authorized representatives, have executed this Agreement with the intention that it shall be effective as of the effective date of the latest governmental resolution referenced in the Recitals hereto.
