

ORDINANCE NO. 1035

TO VACATE PORTION OF AN ALLEY IN THE CHAMPION IRON BRIDGE COMPANY ADDITION TO THE CITY OF WILMINGTON RUNNING WEST FROM SOUTH WALL STREET BETWEEN LOTS NOS. 6 AND 8 OF SAID ADDITION TO ANOTHER ALLEY.

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of April, 1964, by request of the Irwin Auger Bit Company for the vacation of said alley by the Irwin Auger Bit Company, owners of Lots Nos. 6 and 8 in the Champion Iron Bridge Company Addition to the City of Wilmington, notice of the pendency of said request having been given as required by law by publication in the Wilmington News-Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation for six (6) consecutive weeks, and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the portion of the alley in the Champion Iron Bridge Company Addition to the City of Wilmington running west from South Wall Street between Lots Nos. 6 and 8 of said addition to another alley, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
