

ORDINANCE NO. 1156

ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY TO THE REAR OF THE NAZARENE CHURCH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of April, 1966, a petition by the persons owning lots immediately adjacent and adjoining and in the immediate vicinity of an alley running in a north-south direction directly behind the Nazarene Church located at 198 South Walnut Street, Wilmington, Ohio, approximately 16½ feet wide and running 67 feet in length was duly presented to council praying that said alley for the distance of 67 feet be vacated and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, by publication in the Wilmington News Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks ending June 14, 1966; and,

WHEREAS, council, upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

SECTION I - That a certain alley running in a generally north-south direction, 16½ feet wide and 67 feet long from an area bounded on the south by the Wilmington Casting Company, on the west by the land owned by the Nazarene Church and on the east by the land owned by the Nazarene Church and on the north by an alley running in a generally east-west direction be vacated and the same is hereby ordered vacated.

SECTION II - That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
