

ORDINANCE NO. 1195

ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ALLEY IN SPRING  
BIRD SUBDIVISION, CITY OF WILMINGTON, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, OHIO,  
majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1 - That upon recommendation of the street committee  
of the council of the City of Wilmington and the Service Director of  
the City of Wilmington, the newly constructed alley running in a  
general north-south direction from Birdsall Street, a distance of <sup>207</sup>~~200~~  
feet, south into Spring Bird subdivision is hereby accepted by the City  
of Wilmington, Ohio, and the further care and maintenance of said improved  
alley is accepted from this point forward by the said City of Wilmington.

SECTION 2 - This ordinance to be in effect on and after the  
earliest date allowed by law.
