

Ordinance No. 190

TO VACATE A SIXTEEN FOOT ALLEY LOCATED IN E. R. MILL'S GRANDVIEW ADDITION TO THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, OHIO, EXTENDING BETWEEN KENTUCKY AND MICHIGAN AVENUES.

Whereas, on the 7th day of December, 1928, a petition by persons owning lots No. 64 to 68 inclusive and Lot No. 79 in the vicinity and abutting on a sixteen foot alley in E. R. Mill's Grandview Addition to the City of Wilmington, Ohio, extending between Kentucky and Michigan Avenues, was duly presented to Council praying that said alley, between the points named, be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, by publication in the Wilmington News-Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks ending January 21, 1929; and,

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO.

SECTION 1:- That a sixteen foot alley located in E. R. Mill's Grandview Addition to the City of Wilmington, Ohio, extending between Kentucky and Michigan Avenues, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2:- That this ordinance be and the same remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
