

ORDINANCE NO. 191.

TO VACATE A PORTION OF COLUMBUS, STREET IN
DOAN'S SUB-DIVISION AND EXTENSION THERE TO, AND AN
ALLEY SUB-DIVISION TO THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, OHIO.

Whereas on the 5th day of April, 1929, a petition from the owners of lots in the immediate vicinity of Columbus, Street in Doan's Sub-division and extension thereto, in the City of Wilmington, Ohio, to the west line of Applegate Street in said sub-division and extension and in the immediate vicinity of a 16 1/2 foot alley running east and west in said M. E. Doan's sub-division extending from the east line of Applegate Street and aforesaid, was duly presented to council praying that said street and alley, between the points named, be vacated; and the written consent of all the owners of all the property abutting the parts of said street and alley proposed to be vacated having been heretofore on April 5, 1929 filed with this Council; and therefore Council being satisfied that all the owners of all the property abutting on the parts of the street and alley proposed to be vacated, have had due notice thereof and have filed their written consent thereto herein, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:-

SECTION I;- That Columbus Street from the east line of a 16 foot alley running north and south in M. E. Doan's Sub-Division and extension thereto, in the City of Wilmington, Ohio, to the west line of Applegate street in said sub-division and extension, and a 16 1/2 foot alley running east and west in said M. E. Doan's sub-division extending from the east line of aforesaid 16 foot north and south alley to the west line of Applegate Street, be and the same are hereby vacated.

Section 2:- That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
