

TO VACATE PORTION OF AN ALLEY IN THE C. W. FISHER ADDITION TO THE CITY OF WILMINGTON RUNNING EAST FROM THE EXPANSION OF NORTH SOUTH STREET TO A POINT, THENCE SOUTH TO RUBY AVENUE.

Whereas, on the 17th day of May, 1956, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of a certain alley hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council praying that said alley be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law by publication in the News-Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation for six consecutive weeks ending June 28, 1956, and

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the portion of the alley in the C. W. Fisher Addition to the City of Wilmington running east from the extension of North South Street along the north edge of said addition to a point, thence south to Ruby Avenue, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
