ORDINANCE NO. 795

VACATING WHITTIER PLACE IN ITS ENTIRETY FROM THE NORTH MARGIN OF ELM STREET TO THE SOUTH MARGIN OF FIFE AVENUE.

Whereas, by letter dated June 11, 1957 Wilmington College petitioned the Council to vacate the street known and designated as Whitter Place in its entirety, from the north margin of Elm Street to the south margin of Fife Avenue, and

Whereas, it appearing that all property bounded by and abutting upon the said Whittier Place is owned by the petitioner, the publication of notice of the pendency and prayer of such petition is not required, and

Whereas, the Council having considered the same is satisfied that there is good cause for vacating such street, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and that such vacation ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Whittier Place, in its entirety, from the north margin of Elm Street to the south margin of Fife Avenue, be, and the same is hereby, vacated; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall be construed so as to vacate that portion of Douglas Street intersecting the said Whittier Flace.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
