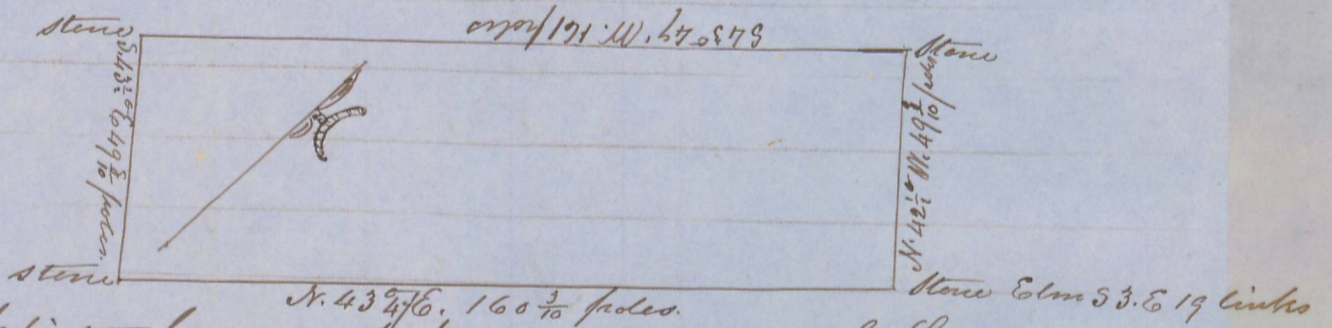

State of Ohio Clinton County ss. In pursuance of an act of the Legislature of Ohio entitled an act to enable the holders of lands within this state to perpetuate testimony relative to their lands passed January 22^d 1824. and by the request of John Bennett I hereby certify that I have surveyed the tract of land on which he lives and which is owned by William Bennett and part of Warringtons Survey No. 1449 as follows. Beginning at a stone marked A on the plat South corner of said Survey No. 1449, and east corner of Andersons and Warringtons Survey No. 550, and west corner of Meads Survey No. 808; thence with the line between survey No. 1449, and 808, N. 43° 47' E. 160 3/10 poles to a stone (marked B on the plat) where an Elm bears N. 3° E. 19 links corner to Zepheniah Underwoods tract of land; thence with the line of said tract N. 42 1/2° W. 49 8/10 poles to a stone (marked C on the plat) corner to another of said Underwoods tracts of land; thence with the line of said tract S. 43° 47' W. passing a stone corner to said tract and Amos Underwoods land at 80 3/10 poles 161 poles to a stone marked D on the plat in the south west line of the original survey, and South corner to Amos Underwoods land; thence with the original line S. 43 1/2° E. 49 8/10 poles to the Beginning, containing fifty acres of land.
