



This certifies that I have laid out the above lots for Jacob Dore as an addition to the Town of New Vienna described as follows. Lots No 1 and 2 are five poles wide by ten poles long. Lots 3, 4 and 5 are fifty six feet and six inches wide by ten poles long. Lot No 6 is 69 feet wide by one hundred sixty nine long as represented on the above Plat. Lot No 7 is sixty six feet wide and fractional extending from the street to the saw mill Lot. Lot 8 is Fifty two feet wide and fractional extending from the street to the saw mill Lot. Lot No 9 and 10 are sixty one feet wide and fractional extending back from the street to Lot 11 and the mill Lot. Lot 11 is fifty feet front on the Millstone Street extending back ten poles on the line of the mill lot it being fractional the street being sixty feet wide and the alleys each one pole wide to correspond with the above plat. I Represent the point of commencement, at a stone.
