

TO VACATE ALLEY RUNNING IN AN EAST-WEST
DIRECTION BETWEEN LOTS 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, AND
11 IN BURROUGH'S HEIRS ADDITION.

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of August, 1964, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 in Burrough's Heirs Addition was duly presented to Council praying that said alley between the area be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of the petition has been given as required by law, by publication in the Star Republican, a newspaper of general circulation in the village, for six consecutive weeks, ending January 22, 1970.

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
BLANCHESTER, OHIO:

Section 1. That an alley in Burrough's Heirs Addition, running in an east-west direction between lots 6, 7, 8, and 9, 10, and 11 in said addition, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. Any and all permanent utility easements in said alley, if any, are hereby reserved for the benefit of said Village.

Section 3. That this ordinance be and remain in force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
