

VACATING ALLEY

Whereas, on the 5th day of October, 1972, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of Fancy Street and South Mill Street was duly presented to Council praying that a certain alley running in a general westerly direction from Mill Street south of the intersection of Fancy Street and along the south margin of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of J. K. Trickey's Sub-division of Outlot 4 of Lazenby's Addition be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law by publication in the Star Republican, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks.


Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That an alley running in a general westerly direction from Mill Street south of the intersection of Fancy Street and along the south margin of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of J. K. Trickey's Subdivision of Outlot 4 of Lazenby's Addition be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
