ORDINANCE NO. 477

TO VACATE ALLEY IN LAZENBY'S ADDITION
TO VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER BETWEEN
BOURBON STREET AND DEPOT STREET.

WHEREAS, a petition by persons owning lots adjoining an alley in Lazenby's Addition to the Village of Blanchester, Ohio, running between Bourbon Street and Depot Street between Lots 27-45 in said subdivision, was presented to Council praying that said alley be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, by publication in the Wilmington News Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the county, for six consecutive weeks ending November 3, 1980 _____; and


WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Ohio:

Section 1. That an alley running between Bourbon Street and Depot Street and adjoining Lots 27-45 in Lazenby's Addition be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
