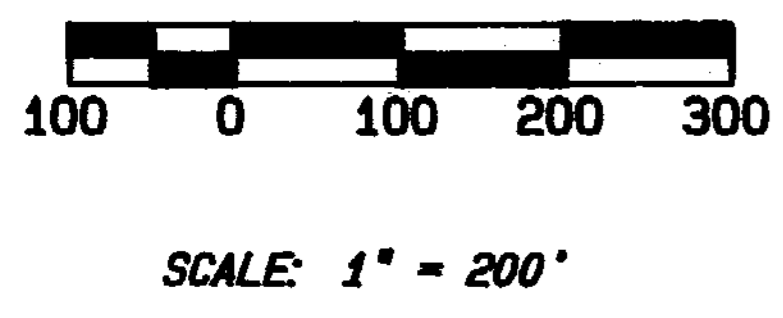
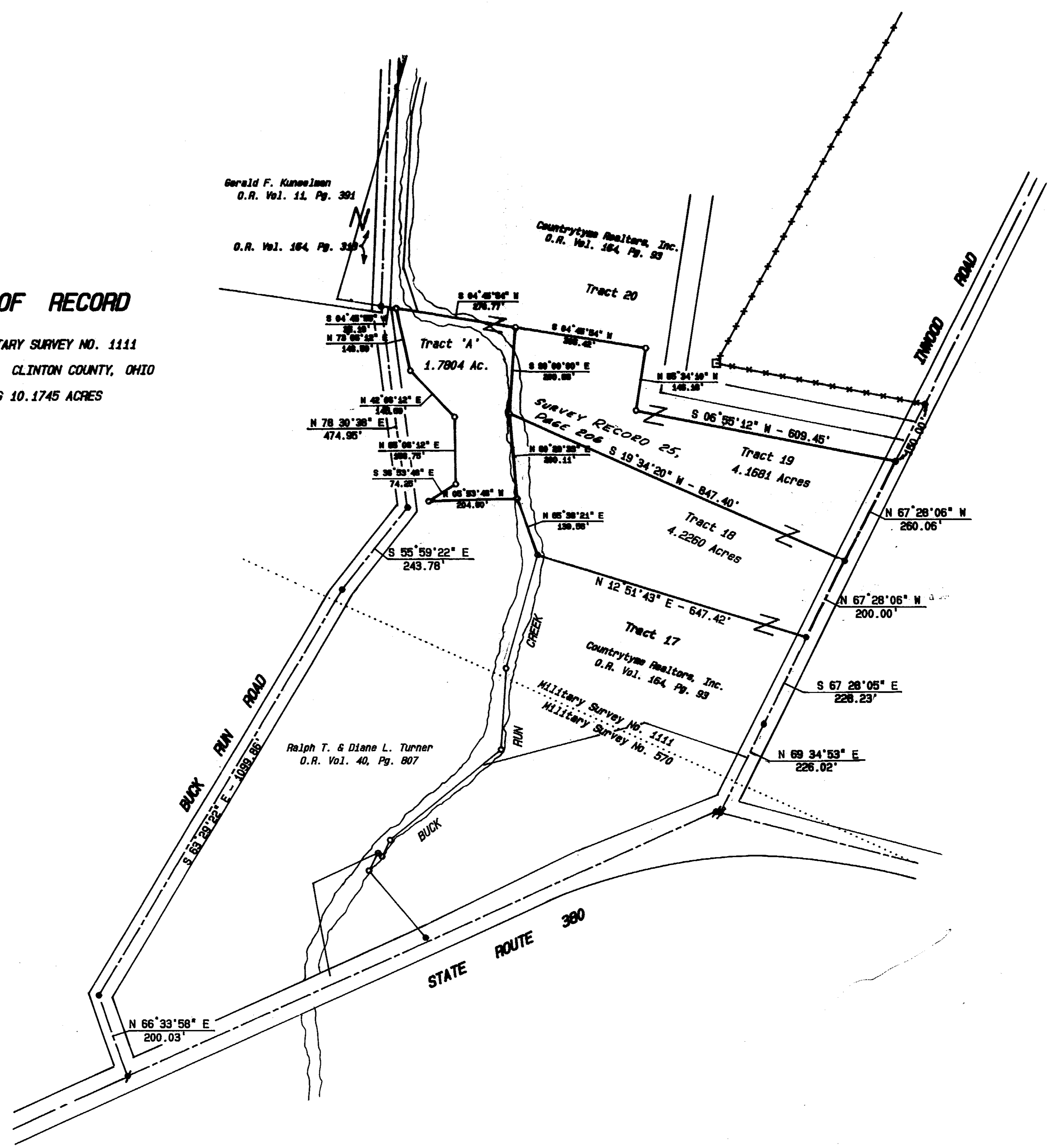


SURVEY OF RECORD
