



Surveyed May 6th 1901
for J. Matson and Associates.

Beginning at a stone "A" ten feet S $1/2$ E from the center of the pine thence parallel with the corner thereof and ten feet therefrom N $51 \frac{1}{4}$ W 16 poles to a stone "B" corner to James Matson thence with his line N $38 \frac{3}{4}$ W 11.40 poles to a stake "C" corner to A and Matson thence again with his line S $51 \frac{1}{4}$ W 12.24 poles to a stake "B" in Rod (Penrod's) line thence with his line S $19 \frac{1}{4}$ E 12.08 poles to the beginning containing one acre of land
