 of the Washington Pike corner to Fannie Vanniman
 thence with said line N 42° 00' 26.36 chains to a stone
 "B" in the south line of the B. & O. S.W.R.R. right-of-way
 thence with said line N 71° E 16.56 chains to a stone
 "C" in said line corner to the Colley land thence with
 the lines of said land as follows S 57° 35' E
 15.68 chains to a stone "I" S 36° W 222 chains to a stone
 "J" S 72° 24' W 1.35 chains to a stone "K" S 41° 40' E 11.66
 chains to an iron pin "L" in the center of the afore-
 said pike thence with the center thereof
 S 72° 24' W 17.46 chains to the beginning containing
 forty four and 2/100 acres
