



Beginning at a stone at "A" in the Original Survey line corner to Samuel Dullivan Thence with the Original line S 20° W 3.33 ch. to a stone "B" in said line corner to Alfred Vantress Thence with his line S 74 1/2° E 6.19 ch. to a stone "C" in his line (Dullivan's) and corner to David Vantress where a stone "E" corner to said Vantress on the east side of the Chester Tp. House and New Burlington Pike Course S 44 1/4° E 3.28 ch. Thence with said Dullivan's line N 44 1/4° West 6.85 chains to the place of beginning so containing 1 1/28 acres of land.
