 record in the Original line at A.
 monuments were placed by us at C E F G.
 H I & J; iron pins at H & I and at the roots
 of the Elm at "B"; stones at C E F G & J in
 the presence of J. S. Roberts, Jesse C. Burnett,
 Joe Doan, Elias Doan, L. C. McCawin,
