

To vacate two (2) unnamed alley's in the Village of Midland, State of Ohio, both in the Mitchell and Smith's First Addition, one (1) from Main to Smith street, the other from High street to the aforesaid alley.

Whereas, on the 21 day of October 1961, one (1) petition by John Smith, lots in the immediate vicinity of two (2) unnamed alley's, both on the East side of High street in the Mitchell and Smith's First Addition, one (1) running from Main to Smith street, the other beginning from the East side of High street and running in an East by direction between lots two (2) and three (3) and ending at the aforesaid alley; was duly presented to council proving that said alley's between the points named, be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, publication in The Star Republican, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks ending January 31, 1962; and,

Whereas, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is no possible cause of objection as proposed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and in public view, now transfer,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MIDLAND, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the unnamed alley in the Mitchell and Smith's First Addition running on the East side of High street from Main to Smith street be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That the unnamed alley in the Mitchell and Smith's First Addition beginning from the East side of High street and running in an easterly direction between lots two (2) and three (3) and ending at the aforesaid alley in section one (1) be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 3. That the aforesaid alley's will revert equally to properties abutting said alley's.

Section 4. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

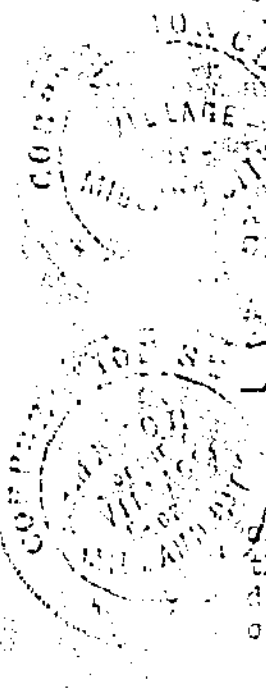
